

UK CHASERS Challenge

What is UK Chasers Challenge?

The challenge/competition is open to every rider at every level it is noncompetitive in the sense that it is not the fastest horse that wins so it give everyone a fair chance.

The competition involves:

- *Cross Country Jumping Section* - jumping round a cross country course over a variety of jumps.
- **Class 1 Minimus – 1'6" and under**
- **Class 2 Novice - 2'6"**
- **Class 3 Pairs - 2'6"** -
- **Class 4 Open - 3'6"**
- *Walking Section* - 250 metres
- *Gate Section* - open and shut a gate
- *Show jumping Section* - no more that 6 show jumps

The whole competition is timed, penalties will incur for refusals or omitting fences, dislodged show jumps, breaking out of walk in the walk section or omitting to close the gate.

NO Rider will be eliminated but could be asked to move on to next obstacle.

THE CATCH!!!

There will be a bogey time already sealed in an envelope and the winner is the nearest to the time! The time will be set at a sensible pace to allow time for obstacles and distance to be

covered safely - the speed of travel will be between 238 and 277 metres per minute.

For the serious people!
Full details of the course length and all compulsory elements will be available on arrival. Entrants must then use their skill and judgement allowing for ground conditions etc to assess the bogey time!

For the fun people – just have a go and enjoy it!
This challenge is designed to be enjoyed by all and have fun!

Rules

The challenge is open to members and non members

Horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over

No horse/pony can entry more that one class except the pairs.

The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Well behaved dogs on leads with pooh bag only!

Withdrawals (horse and rider). Entry money will be refunded in full only if accompanied by vet's or doctor's certificate. The committee reserves the right to cancel or postpone the event –entry money will be refunded at 80%.

Conditions of Entry: All entrants take part at their own risk. The organisers and land owner do not accept any liability, including negligence for any accident injury loss or damage to any person animal or property at the event or arisen there from. Entrants are very strongly advised to have their own Personal Accident Riding Insurance.

Any dispute shall be referred to the Chief Steward whose decision is final. All competitors must wear crash hats and proper footwear; body protectors are

strongly advised. No entries will be accepted without remittance.

How to find us:

Take the A19 to Easingwold, take the sign to the Market Place – follow the road through the market place it slightly bends right along Uppleby (grass either side of the road in front of the houses) then you come to a little cross road (Post box on your left) turn left here signed Coxwold and Oulston. Go up the hill (New housing estate on your left) down the hill into the country take the next turn left signed Thornton Hill. (Road slightly bends right) we are the 2nd on the right hand side signed Thornton Lodge Farm and Farmstay UK

Or coming in from Thirsk A19 to the first roundabout signed Easingwold 200 yds to white house either side of the road turn left past Low Moors Tack Shop to the T junction straight on. The road bare left 90% to Hushwaite **but you take the** little road straight on slight right. To the end (Point to Point Course in front of you) T junction turn left second farm on the right.
